

## See it all with SydneyPass

SydneyPass is the only 3, 5 and 7 day ticket that includes premium sightseeing tours as well as regular bus, train and ferry services. Convenient, flexible and economical, SydneyPass is the perfect travel companion.

### SydneyPass ticket includes:

- **The Sydney Explorer Bus**  
– hop on & off at 27 of Sydney's most famous landmarks
- **The Bondi Explorer Bus**  
– hop on & off at 19 picturesque harbour, bay and beach locations
- **The entire Sydney Ferries network**  
– See Sydney from the water, visit beautiful Manly, Taronga Zoo & more
- **The entire Sydney Buses network**  
– the easy way to get around town
- **CityRail trains**  
– for travel in the CBD & surrounding suburbs
- **Airport Link train transfers**  
– the fastest way to & from the airport.

Travelling on AirportLink will not activate the entire SydneyPass ticket, just the Airport transfer component of the ticket. The 3, 5 and 7 days will not start until the ticket is used on another service. The Airport Link return transfer is valid for 2 months from the date the SydneyPass is activated.

### Regular Ferry, Bus & Rail Services

- **Sydney Ferries:** Access the entire Sydney Ferries network. See Sydney from the water, take a Rivercat to Parramatta or travel by ferry across the harbour to any one of 36 wharves.

- **Sydney Buses:** Access the entire Sydney Buses network (300 services).
- **CityRail Trains:** Covers limited area of CityRail network, shown in red on travel map.

### 'Red' Sydney Explorer

The Sydney Explorer stops at 27 famous Sydney landmarks and attractions. It is the only timetabled hop on hop off sightseeing bus that travels to Chinatown, through the Royal Botanic Gardens and across the Sydney Harbour Bridge.

- Buses run every 20 minutes.
- Allow 2 hours to complete the round trip.
- First bus departs from Circular Quay at 8.40am, last bus departs 5.20pm returning 7.20pm.
- All buses are air-conditioned and include on board commentary.
- Service runs year round.

### 'Blue' Bondi Explorer

The Bondi Explorer stops at 19 harbour, bay and beach locations. It is the only hop on hop off service that stops at picturesque Rushcutters Bay, Vaucluse, Watsons Bay, Bronte Beach and Coogee Beach. Each of these unique locations offer some of the best views of Sydney harbour, Sydney heads and the adjoining coastline.

- Buses run every 30 minutes
- Allow 2 hours to complete the round trip.
- First bus departs from Circular Quay at 8.45am, last bus departs 4.15pm returning 6.15pm.
- All services include on board commentary.
- All buses are air-conditioned and wheelchair accessible.
- Service runs year round.
